2. Purchase a half festival pass which will get you 5 films of your choosing for \$65 (\$10 Savings!)

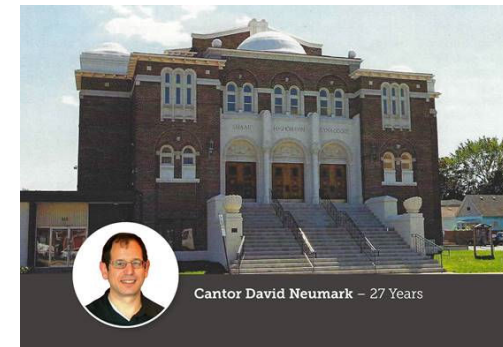
Tickets

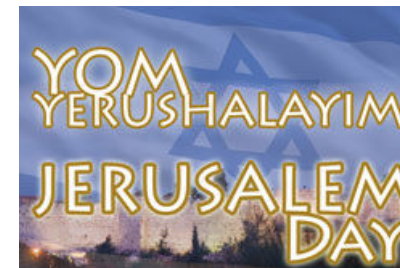

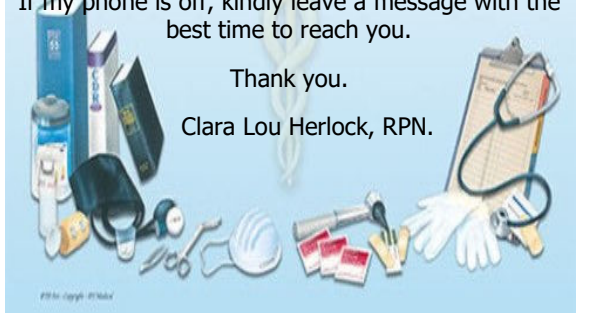

name, preferably in Hebrew, i.e., Rivka bat Sara. An interesting item to note: Prayers for the sick reference the sick person's mother's name and prayers for someone who is receiving an *aliyah* reference the person's father's name. According to Jewish law, a father's name is like a surname, used only for the purpose of identification. A mother, however, is associated with life and the soul.
