BINGO REPORT

 Bingos are up and running again and the results have been financially fantastic! The 2 cheques we've received so far have averaged almost \$1,500 each! The only problem we are having is the lack of volunteers.

We've had 5 bingos and one person, Nir Frenkel, has worked 4 of them. We almost needed to give up two assignments, but Nir saved the day by filling in at the last minute. We even could not accept extra assignments that were offered due to the difficulty in the volunteer process. Indeed, the 5 bingos used only 3 different volunteers. This is not a sustainable situation. A number of our previous volunteers have not, for one reason or another, stepped up. A few of our volunteers are out of town or no longer capable physically.

This problem needs to be rectified soon or we will lose an important source of our funding.

Many members of our congregation receive reduced assessments based on their financial situation. Many on the Board of Directors have suggested that those members be required (if physically able) to provide volunteer hours to offset those reductions.

We are not suggesting that be mandatory. But if you are in that situation, please consider, perhaps as a moral obligation, volunteering even once every few months. If you can do so, contact me or Katerina at the office, for more details.

When the Torah reading is completed, prayers are offered for those seeking recovery from illness (*mischeberach*). The congregants tell the *Gabbai* the sick person's name and mother's name, preferably in Hebrew, i.e., Rivka bat Sara.

An interesting item to note: Prayers for the sick reference the sick person's mother's name and prayers for someone who is receiving an *aliyah* reference the person's father's name. According to Jewish law, a father's name is like a surname, used only for the purpose of identification. A mother, however, is associated with life and the soul. Ukrainian-Jewish Windsor Resettlement Fund Appeal

Jewish Immigrant Aid Services has convened a central task force composed of Jewish communities to plan for the imminent influx of Ukrainian Jews expected to arrive in Canada in the coming months. The WJCC's Michelle Turnbull represents Windsor on this task force.

The Windsor Jewish Federation & Community Centre, Chabad, Congregation Shaar Hashomayim and Temple Beth El are partnering to launch a Ukrainian-Jewish Windsor Resettlement Fund. This special fund will be used to assist Ukrainian-Jewish newcomers to Windsor with the necessities to build new lives, until it is safe to return to Ukraine. Because we do not know how many Jewish Ukrainians will arrive in Windsor, any excess funding will be sent to Jewish Immigrant Aid Services and channeled to communities in need.
