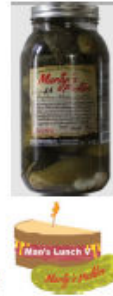

MESSAGE FROM THE ACTING-PRESIDENT

To get to the High Holidays, we have to first visit the DELI. THE MAN'S LUNCH #5 will be here on Thursday, September 22nd, 2022, at 11:30 am. Once we clean up the social hall, then you're right, it's the High Holidays and of course, our essential YIZKOR Appeal.

The Shaar's financials are not good, in fact we started August with no money in our account and we had to increase the line of credit to make payroll. There is no hiding the TRUTH; we manage every financial aspect of the business known as Congregation Shaar Hashomayim, but we raise money in the fall, spend it all year and run out just before the High Holidays. Well, with inflation, fuel and energy cost continuing to rise and major repairs at the cemetery, we ran out of money.

We have gained members and we are going to gain some more; the applications are being filled out, we have maintained enrollment at the Hebrew School and a few more students are possibly going to register. The Man's Lunch is being set up for a record 292 seats and we sold ALL 34 tables. We have had several donations for The Man's Lunch's High End Silent Auction. We will be having a 50/50 draw. The pickle jars on every table, ready to accept gelt and mustard and pickles for sale.

Our other avenue to raise funds to sustain our Synagogue is the Yizkor appeal. This year, I cannot make personal calls and appeal for funds, as I'm too busy planning the production

of hundreds of juicy, hot and steamy, delicious, mouth-watering KOSHER corned beef, bold and spicy pastrami, montreal spiced smoke meat and Robbie Katzman's world famous baked salami.

The Shaar is a busy place with lots going on and yes, we have Yontif, too.

See you soon, as September is going to be a GREAT Shaar month.

When the Torah reading is completed, prayers are offered for those seeking recovery from illness (*misheberach*). The congregants tell the *Gabbai* the sick person's name and mother's name, preferably in Hebrew, i.e., Rivka bat Sara.

An interesting item to note: Prayers for the sick reference the sick person's mother's name and prayers for someone who is receiving an *aliyah* reference the person's father's name. According to Jewish law, a father's name is like a surname, used only for the purpose of identification. A mother, however, is associated with life and the soul. 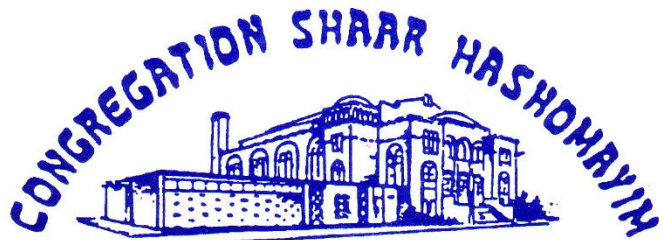
