RABBI YOSIL ROSENZWEIG (AH) SCHOLARSHIP FUND

A number of our members have expressed an interest in achieving a permanent memorial in our synagogue to **Rabbi Yosil Rosenzweig (AH)** who passed away on June 21st, 2023. For those of you who don't know, he was our Rabbi from 1989 to 1997 and although not born in Windsor, spent all his childhood and teenage years here. A **Scholarship Fund** has been suggested to be established in his name, the income of which would be used to encourage Jewish education, particularly in our religious school, which was always a priority with him, as he established a deep rapport with the students of our school while he was here. Any individual (or shared) donation of \$1,000 or more can be recognised on our Scholarship Board in the hallway of our school. If a total of at least \$10,000 is achieved, a larger memorial plaque will also be placed on the appropriate donation board and will be permanently noted as a separate Scholarship Fund in our financial statement and records. We encourage our membership to honour his memory by not only contributing to this Fund, but by encouraging others who may not be aware of its existence to do so. As with all donations, tax deductible receipts will be issued and acknowledgements will be sent to the rabbi's survivors.
