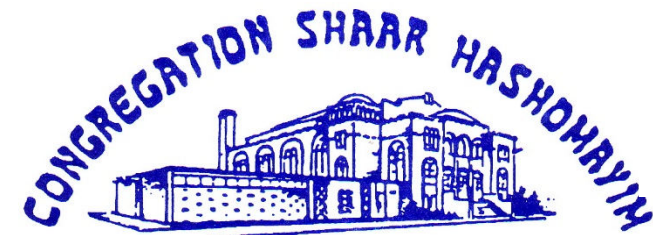

Moshe presents to the nation the blessing of a spiritually oriented life, and the curse of becoming disconnected from Hashem. When the nation enters Eretz Yisrael they must burn down any trees that had been used for idol-worship, and destroy all idolatrous statues. Hashem will choose only one place where the Divine Presence will dwell. Offerings may be brought only there; not to a private altar. Moshe repeatedly warns against eating animal blood. In the desert, all meat was slaughtered in the Mishkan, but in Eretz Yisrael meat may be shechted anywhere. Moshe lists the categories of food that may be eaten only in Jerusalem. He warns the nation against copying the ways of the other nations. Since the Torah is complete and perfect, nothing may be added to or subtracted from it. If a "prophet" tells the people to permanently abandon a Torah law or indulge in idol worship, he is to be put to death. One who entices others to worship idols is to be put to death. A city of idolatry must be razed. It is prohibited to show excessive signs of mourning, such as marking the skin or making a bald spot. Moshe reiterates the classifications of kosher and non-kosher food and the prohibition of cooking meat and milk. Produce of the second tithe must be eaten in Jerusalem, and if the amount is too large to carry, it may be exchanged for money with which food is bought in Jerusalem. In certain years this tithe is given to the poor. Bnei Yisrael are instructed to always be open-hearted, and in the seventh year any loans must be discounted then Hashem will bless the person in all ways. A Jewish bondsman is released after six years and must be sent away with generous provisions. If he refuses to leave, his ear is pierced with an awl at the door post and he remains a bondsman until the Jubilee Year. The Parsha ends with a description of the three pilgrimage festivals of Pesach, Shavuot and Succot.

RABBI YOSIL ROSENZWEIG (AH) SCHOLARSHIP FUND

A number of our members have expressed an interest in achieving a permanent memorial in our synagogue to **Rabbi Yosil Rosenzweig (AH)** who passed away on June 21st, 2023. For those of you who don't know, he was our Rabbi from 1989 to 1997 and although not born in Windsor, spent all his childhood and teenage years here. A **Scholarship Fund** has been suggested to be established in his name, the income of which would be used to encourage Jewish education, particularly in our religious school, which was always a priority with him, as he established a deep rapport with the students of our school while he was here. Any individual (or shared) donation of \$1,000 or more can be recognised on

our Scholarship Board in the hallway of our school. If a total of at least \$10,000 is achieved, a larger memorial plaque will also be placed on the appropriate donation board and will be permanently noted as a separate Scholarship Fund in our financial statement and records. We encourage our membership to honour his memory by not only contributing to this Fund, but by encouraging others who may not be aware of its existence to do so. As with all donations, tax deductible receipts will be issued and acknowledgements will be sent to the rabbi's survivors.
