The Salvation Army is in touch with many families of all faiths who have little or no money to make it through the new year. The Family Matching Program matches donor families with the needy in our community.

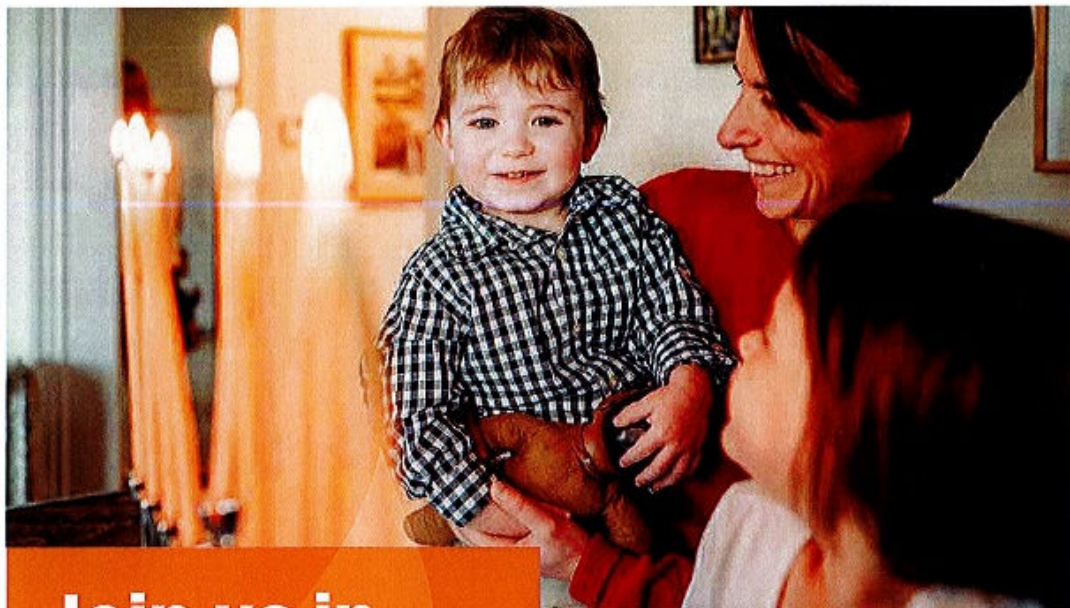
Last year, we were able to help many families and raised over \$7,100.00 for 29 families through The Salvation Army.

PRAYER FOR THE SICK

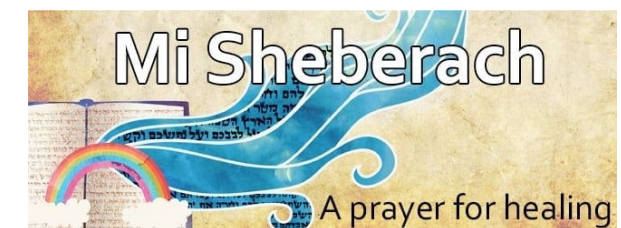


During the Torah reading, prayers are offered for those seeking recovery from illness (*misheberach*).

The congregants tell the *Gabbai* the sick person's name and mother's name, preferably in Hebrew, i.e., Rivka bat Sara.

An interesting item to note: Prayers for the sick reference the sick person's mother's name and prayers for someone who is receiving an *aliyah* reference the person's father's name. According to Jewish law, a father's name is like a surname, used only for the purpose of identification. A mother, however, is associated with life and the soul. A MESSAGE FROM DAVID ABRAHAM

A number of our members have expressed an interest in achieving a permanent memorial in our synagogue to Rabbi Yosil Rosenzweig (AH) who passed away on June 21st, 2023. For those of you who don't know, he was our Rabbi from 1989 to 1997 and although not born in Windsor, spent all his childhood and teenage years here. Personally, in my teenage years, I knew him well and was particularly close with his family and siblings.

My son and I are suggesting that a Scholarship Fund be established in his name, the income of which would be used to encourage Jewish education, particularly in our religious school, which was always a priority with him, as he established a deep rapport with the students of our school while he was here. Any individual (or shared) donation of \$1,000 or more can be recognised on our Scholarship Board in the hallway of our school. If a total of at least \$10,000 is achieved, a larger memorial plaque will also be placed on the appropriate donation board and will be permanently noted as a separate Scholarship Fund in our financial statement and records.

We encourage our membership to honour his memory by not only contributing to this Fund, but by encouraging others who may not be aware of its existence to do so.

As with all donations, tax deductible receipts will be issued and acknowledgements will be sent to the rabbi's survivors.

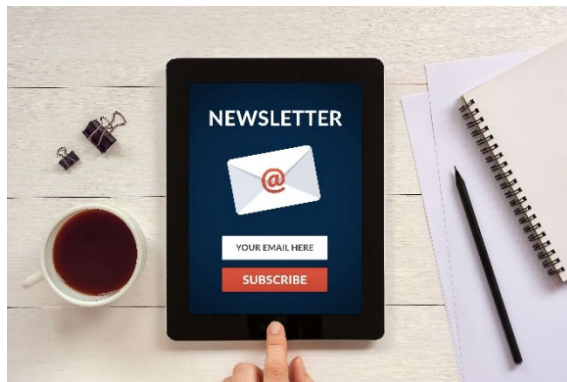

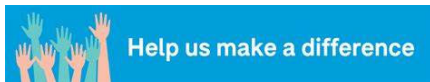
