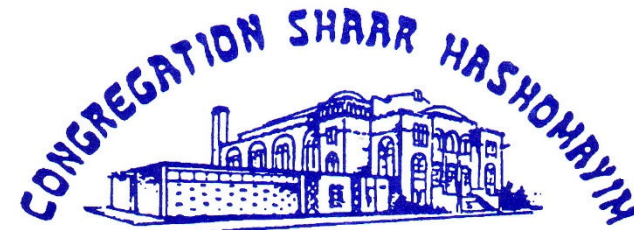

TORAH PORTION:

Shemini Atzeret is concluding Yom Tov of the Sukkot holiday. We read Deuteronomy 14:22 – 16:17, which includes the topics of: tithing crops, remission of loans during the Shemitah year and to be warm-hearted and open-handed to the destitute. Passover, Shavuot and Sukkot are the Shelosh Regalim, the three pilgrimage festivals.

Simchat Torah. We read Vezot Habracha to complete the Book of Deuteronomy and thus the whole Torah. This Torah portion begins with the blessing of Moshe, right before he dies, for the Jewish people and each tribe. He dies, is buried in the valley in an unknown spot and the Jewish people mourn for 30 days. The Torah then concludes with the words, "Never again has there arisen in Israel a prophet like Moses, whom the Almighty had known face to face..."
