MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

June 2025

Hello Everyone,

WE ARE IN A TIME OF NEED!

This has been a very difficult week as President, as the Shul has been overrun with numerous repairs all at once.

As Howard and myself and the Board of Directors and Committee Chairs deal with this plight, we are caught in a NO-WIN SITUATION.



The large Commercial Lawn Mower at the Cemetery must be immediately replaced and the new unit will be very expensive. In addition, this new asset must be safely and securely stored, which will require a storage container/shed as fast as we can source.

The air conditioning system at the Rachel Kaplan Chapel has been stolen and insurance will not cover the full extent of the replacement required, due to installation concerns we must now address.

The air conditioning for the Shaar Chapel and Shaar Offices was just replaced, as this was absolutely needed, but diminished our on-hand funds.



The Kitchen was just professionally cleaned to have us prepared for the three upcoming Simchas: Emma Zeller's Bat Mitzvah on Saturday, June 7th, Ayla Adler's Bat Mizvah on Saturday, June 28th and



Shlomo Tzvi Galperin's Bar Mitzvah on Saturday, June 21st. Also, we have an incredible Father's Day deli/cholent enhanced Shabbat Kiddush on Saturday, June 14th;

MANDATORY that all FRESSERS attend, because that's what FRESSERS do; they eat deli and CHOLENT and not just CHOLENT. It's a Special Lazarus FAMILY RECIPE Cholent.

While cleaning the kitchens, it was identified that three of the five meat ovens are in an immediate state of repair and have been taken out of service. WE are addressing this as I type, as the kitchen must be fully functional.

So the point here is all the monies we raised in September 2024 via Membership Dues, the Man's Lunch and the Yizkor Appeal, have been exhausted and we will not receive any more funds until this September. WE need dollars RIGHT now! Now !! NOW !!!



We are spending funds we do not have, to get all the above done, but I'm asking, please send in your YIZKOR 2025 donation now, to help us fund all of the above repairs and asset replacements.

Being President is not enjoyable; this is a job, a duty and I, like all the Past Presidents, do it; we have a role and a responsibility.

Please ease the burden and support.

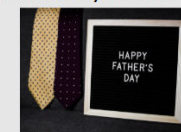

The congregants tell the *Gabbai* the sick person's name and mother's name, preferably in Hebrew, i.e., Rivka bat Sara.

An interesting item to note: Prayers for the sick reference the sick person's mother's name and prayers for someone who is receiving an *aliyah* reference the person's father's name. According to Jewish law, a father's name is like a surname, used only for the purpose of identification. A mother, however, is associated with life and the soul. Subject: Tombstone

A tombstone contains the Jewish names of the deceased in Hebrew, preceded by the letters פ"נ, which is an acronym for פה נטמן ("here lies"). Generally, Ashkenazim also include the father's name, and Sephardim include the mother's name, and it is not uncommon to include both. If the deceased was a Kohen or Levite, the father's name is used. The Jewish date of passing should also be included.

It is traditional to write on the bottom תהא נפשו/ה, which stands for ת.נ.צ.ב.ה., "may his/her soul be bound in the bond of life." Avoid writing excessive or inaccurate praise of the deceased.

Tax Planning-Planned Giving Plan now to save taxes later.

Let's consider David, who owns \$100,000.00 of bank stock which he bought decades ago at \$40,000.00. He also had \$250,000.00 remaining in his RRIF. Without any planning, his tax bill for the year of death would be approximately \$15,000 of capital gains tax on the bank stock and up to \$134,000 of tax on the RRIF, depending on his other income in the year of death.

If David decides to leave the \$100,000 bank stock to a charity in his will, he will save the \$15,000 in capital gains tax upon death, and get a donation receipt for \$100,000 which can save him approximately \$50,000 in tax when applied against the tax owing on the RRIF.

The Charity gets \$100,000.00 and the estate has saved \$65,000.00 in tax.

As with any tax-planned giving, be sure to consult with your tax advisor and lawyer to ensure these strategies make sense in the context of your entire estate plan.

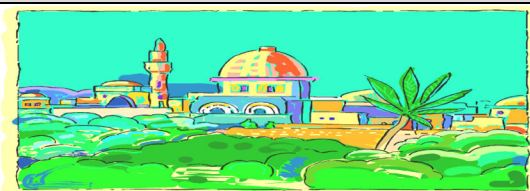

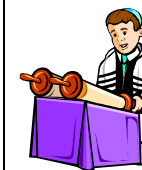

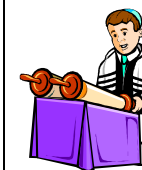
