## MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

September 2025

Happy New Year Everyone. It's been a wonderful year, blessed with many simchas at the Shaar. Bar Mitzvah's, Bat Mitzvah's, Katerina's 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, the biggest and best Man's Lunch ever and a big graduating class from the Hebrew School.

As I emphasized in my last message, the needs at the Shaar are the same this month as last month. The Yizkor Appeal is required to raise the necessary funds to pay for by-law improvements, as a result of our kitchen upgrades.

Excerpt from August 2025 Newsletter:

*"This year the Yizkor Appeal is most urgently needing support, as we have incurred further Kitchen updates to bring the kitchen up to City Code. The Fire Suppression System, Fire Safety Monitoring Panel upgrade, Gas Safety Shut-Off Valving and New Exhaust Systems, are required for both the Milk and Meat kitchens and this is beyond the new Stoves and Ovens. The Zekelman Families got us out of a dire situation, but we still need to raise funds to complete these updates. Please follow along the path the Zekelman's started; they are an inspiration to support and continue on the Shaar, to see it to its 100-year anniversary. We are anticipating to earn in excess of \$ 15,000.00 through the Man's Lunch, but the upgrades list above and currently on order, total \$ 45,500.00. Thus, we need to raise \$ 30,500.00, as our goal for this year's Yizkor Appeal.*

*We have spelled out our exact need and costs for these ongoing expenditures. We as a Board have done our part to repair and service the shul; now we need the membership to help provide funds."*

The Man's Lunch helps pay a portion, but the Yizkor Appeal is our only other revenue source to funds these upgrades.

The Yizkor Appeal, every year, sustains our 96-year-old beautiful synagogue. Your support of the Yizkor Appeal is our lifeline to tomorrow, as we approach of 100-year anniversary in 2029.

Please as always, be generous to the Shaar.

During the Torah reading, prayers are offered for those seeking recovery from illness (*misheberach*). The congregants tell the *Gabbai* the sick person's name and mother's name, preferably in Hebrew, i.e., Rivka bat Sara.

An interesting item to note: Prayers for the sick reference the sick person's mother's name and prayers for someone who is receiving an *aliyah* reference the person's father's name. According to Jewish law, a father's name is like a surname, used only for the purpose of identification. A mother, however, is associated with life and the soul. ### MORNING MINYAN AT THE SHAAH

To request a morning minyan for the observance of yahrzeit, or for the mourners' Kaddish to be said in memory of a loved one, please contact the Shaar office at 519-256-3123 or [shaar@mnsi.net](mailto:shaar@mnsi.net)

### Subject: Tombstone

A tombstone contains the Jewish names of the deceased in Hebrew, preceded by the letters פ"נ, which is an acronym for פה נטמן ("here lies"). Generally, Ashkenazim also include the father's name, and Sephardim include the mother's name, and it is not uncommon to include both. If the deceased was a Kohen or Levite, the father's name is used. The Jewish date of passing should also be included.

It is traditional to write on the bottom תהא נפשו/ה, which stands for ת.נ.צ.ב.ה, צרורה בצרור החיים "may his/her soul be bound in the bond of life." Avoid writing excessive or inaccurate praise of the deceased.

### Tax Planning-Planned Giving Plan now to save taxes later.

Let's consider David, who owns \$100,000.00 of bank stock which he bought decades ago at \$40,000.00. He also had \$250,000.00 remaining in his RRIF. Without any planning, his tax bill for the year of death would be approximately \$15,000 of capital gains tax on the bank stock and up to \$134,000 of tax on the RRIF, depending on his other income in the year of death.

If David decides to leave the \$100,000 bank stock to a charity in his will, he will save the \$15,000 in capital gains tax upon death, and get a donation receipt for \$100,000 which can save him approximately \$50,000 in tax when applied against the tax owing on the RRIF.

The Charity gets \$100,000.00 and the estate has saved \$65,000.00 in tax. As with any tax-planned giving, be sure to consult with your tax advisor and lawyer to ensure these strategies make sense in the context of your entire estate plan.

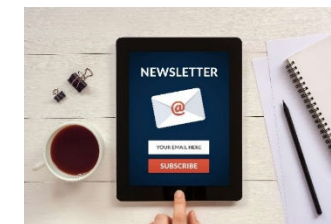

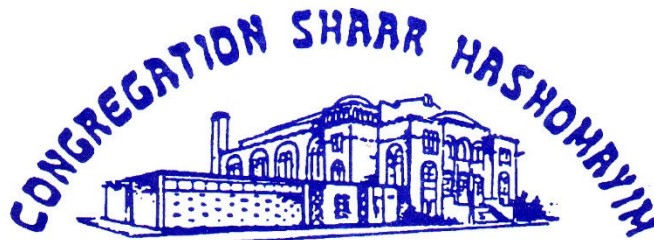
