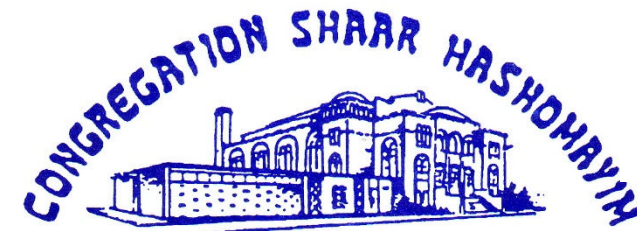

SUKKOT

Torah Parsha – First Day & Second Day: Leviticus 22:26 – 23:44: Pg. 518

Maftir – First Day & Second Day: Numbers 29:12 – 16: Pg. 697

Haftorah – First Day: Zechariah 14:1 – 21: Pg. 972

Haftorah – Second Day: Kings 1 8:2 – 21: Pg. 977

PARSHA (Torah): LEVITICUS 22:26 – 23:44

This Torah reading deals with Shabbos and the Yom Tovim. We are reminded of the kedusha, the holiness, of time. On these occasions we can cease from work and business, pause, and reflect on the true meaning of our life, and our relationship with Hashem.

HAFTORAH FIRST DAY: ZECHARIAH 14:1 – 21

The prophet Zechariah brings renewed hope to his people, when they were discouraged by the difficulties encountered in returning to Israel from the exile. In this last chapter, Zechariah proclaims the vision of Hashem's judgement on the enemies of Israel, and Israel's geulah, redemption.

HAFTORAH SECOND DAY: KINGS I 8:2 – 21

Shlomoh Hamelekh, King Solomon, dedicates the first Beis Hamikdash, Temple, in Jerusalem. This dedication extended over fourteen days, the last seven being the days of Sukkos.
