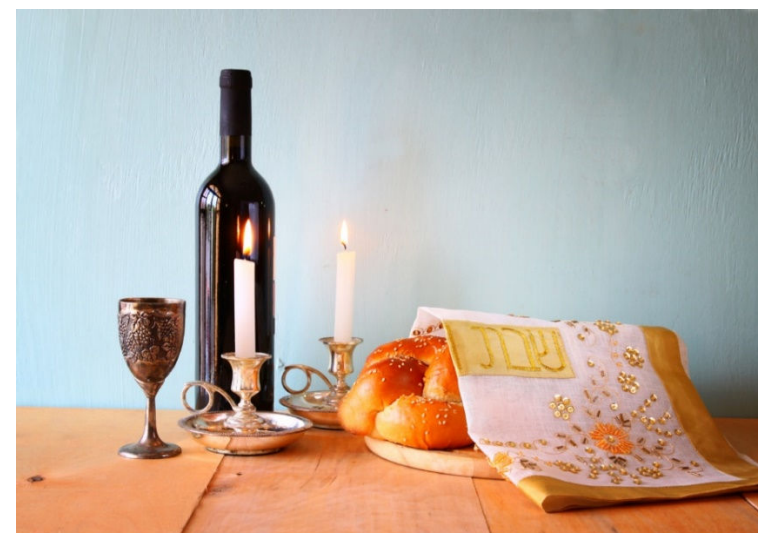

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

February 2026

Man's it cold outside:

Everyone, this is the tough month, hard to get minyans, it's cold, we need to fix the walk-in Milk and Meat Kitchen Coolers, and our dear essential man with many hats, David Lazarus, is laid up recuperating from surgeries.

When one of our Minyan ten goes down, we don't have a replacement. This past Sunday, with Mani Melnick in Arizona and the Rabbi in Detroit, we didn't have a Sunday regular to lead Shacharis. I can do from Barchue, but I'm slow.

Brian Lazarus bailed us out, Tzvi saw this coming the night before and Brian filled in; man he is fast. The minyan is a fragile element of the Shaar; don't think the other guy is just going to be there, we are lean.

Our two walk-in coolers, at well over 45 years old, both failed the same week. This will be an almost \$20,000.00 major repair. Our Hebrew School floor replacement has been stopped, as we need to raise \$30,000.00 to complete the project and this needs funding. Howard and I are reaching out to individuals and Jewish Agencies to help. Our snow removal and salting costs will be triple this year, as the weather has not played nice; we are the sunny, warm south of Canada, we are South Detroit, but not this year and these are expenses we have no way around.

We do have good news. Dylan Hurley Trollip, Diane and Arnie's grandson, is getting Bar Mitzvah'd the end of March. Well done to Dylan and Rabbi Galperin. Another proud day at the Shaar.

With Marion Zeller's efforts, the Shaar was safety-assessed again, to keep us safe and up to date and we await the latest report and recommendations.

Purim is right around the corner and a lot of significance, as the Iranian people are getting closer and closer to freedom and safety.

Stay warm everyone.

The congregants tell the *Gabbai* the sick person's name and mother's name, preferably in Hebrew, i.e., Rivka bat Sara.

An interesting item to note: Prayers for the sick reference the sick person's mother's name and prayers for someone who is receiving an *aliyah* reference the person's father's name. According to Jewish law, a father's name is like a surname, used only for the purpose of identification. A mother, however, is associated with life and the soul. To request a morning minyan for the observance of yahrzeit, or for the mourners' Kaddish to be said in memory of a loved one, please contact the Shaar office at 519-256-3123 or shaar@mnsi.net

Subject: Tombstone

A tombstone contains the Jewish names of the deceased in Hebrew, preceded by the letters פ"נ, which is an acronym for פה נטמן ("here lies"). Generally, Ashkenazim also include the father's name, and Sephardim include the mother's name, and it is not uncommon to include both. If the deceased was a Kohen or Levite, the father's name is used. The Jewish date of passing should also be included. It is traditional to write on the bottom ת.נ.צ.ב.ה. ברוך ה' אלהינו, which stands for תהא נפשו/ה צרוה בצרור החיים, "may his/her soul be bound in the bond of life." Avoid writing excessive or inaccurate praise of the deceased.

Tax Planning-Planned Giving Plan now to save taxes later.
