New news: Brian Lass has decided to return for a second stint as President of Congregation Shaarei Shomayim in Toronto. He is a good friend of Howard Spinner and also my sister-in-law, Myra Mechanic's brother-in-law. Brian comes every year to the Man's Lunch and supports us.

Recently, the Shaarei Shomayim in Toronto was one of two Toronto Synagogues hit by gunfire just before Shabbat service on March 7, 2026. Brian is really taking on a big shul with lots of concerns.

This makes us reflect how fortunate we are with Rabbi Galperin's involvement with Windsor Police Service as their Chaplain and the wonderful relationship we enjoy with WPS and Chief Jason Crowley.

Everyone, always come forward should you experience any antisemitism; between Marion Zeller and her team, Rabbi Galperin and the Shaar, we will act. My daughter and son just experienced antisemitism for the first time at the First Robotics Competition at the University of Windsor. We immediately went after the organizers of First and

they deflected the incident to First of Canada's President, Dave Ellis.

Dave and I spoke at length and he explained he has no knowledge of any religion, he also doesn't follow World Politics and used his ignorance as his defense. Not good enough. We went after the high school in London of the boy that intimidated our kids and they apologized immediately. First, on the other hand, felt it didn't break the Human Right Act of Canada, so they are limited. Well, not good enough. First Robotics is a gracious professionalism-based group of fairness, sportsmanship, with core values of discovery, innovation, impact, inclusion and teamwork and fun. Hatred, death to Jews and the destruction of the State of Israel have no place in this world. First International is being addressed formally. The rights of the innocent must be protected.

Why do I bring this up? Because the WJCC, CIJA and B'nai Brith, fight for us daily. We have been blessed living in Windsor. Marion Zeller was on the front page of the Windsor Star, standing up. Let's all say Thanks.

The congregants tell the *Gabbai* the sick person's name and mother's name, preferably in Hebrew, i.e., Rivka bat Sara.

An interesting item to note: Prayers for the sick reference the sick person's mother's name and prayers for someone who is receiving an *aliyah* reference the person's father's name. According to Jewish law, a father's name is like a surname, used only for the purpose of identification. A mother, however, is associated with life and the soul. Our community is also seeking Shomers. After a Jewish person passes away, it is customary for someone to stay with the body at all times until burial. If needed, several people take shifts. MORNING MINYAN AT THE SHAAH

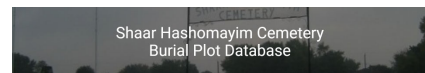
To request a morning minyan for the observance of yahrzeit, or for the mourners' Kaddish to be said in memory of a loved one, please contact the Shaar office at 519-256-3123 or shaar@mnsi.net

Subject: Tombstone

A tombstone contains the Jewish names of the deceased in Hebrew, preceded by the letters פ"ה, which is an acronym for פה נטמן ("here lies"). Generally, Ashkenazim also include the father's name, and Sephardim include the mother's name, and it is not uncommon to include both. If the deceased was a Kohen or Levite, the father's name is used. The Jewish date of passing should also be included.

It is traditional to write on the bottom ת.נ.צ.ב.ה, which stands for תהא נפשוה צרוה בצרוה החיים, "may his/her soul be bound in the bond of life." Avoid writing excessive or inaccurate praise of the deceased.

Tax Planning-Planned Giving Plan now to save taxes later.
